Clarifications regarding the rights according to this agreement, see below:

For frozen semen from a male dog that the seller holds with retained breeding rights or as a fosterer dog, the above agreement must not go beyond the rights the seller has agreed with the dog's buyer/fosterer. This means that the number of litters for the male dog must not exceed the number specified in the purchase agreement with retained breeding rights/fosterer agreement stipulations and that no inseminations may take place after ownership/breeding rights have passed to the buyer/fosterer.

Before making the sale, think carefully about the conditions for it based on your breed's population, the dog's previous offspring, etc.
